Smooth and dense with hints of raisins and figs macerated in alcohol emerge with aeration on the long smooth finish. Easygoing yet very concentrated Amarone that boasts noteworthy purità. My guess is this will be ready to drink sooner than most other 2013 Amarones. Smooth, dense and suave, offering sneaky concentration and real poise along with rich, chewy red cherry, quinine and sweet spice flavors. Very long and youthfully chewy on the finish.
